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Keith R. Molenaar is dean of the College of Engineering and Applied Science and the K. Stanton Lewis Professor at the University of Colorado Boulder. As dean, he leads more than 12,000 faculty, staff, and students in meeting the mission for the state's flagship engineering college. His research and teaching focus on the application of emerging technologies and management practices to engineering design and construction, project delivery, and risk management. He has authored more than 250 technical reports and articles and performed project delivery and risk-related consulting for a variety of projects including the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge in California, the Panama Canal Expansion in Panama, the Long Baseline Neutrino Facility/Deep Underground Neutrino Experiment in Illinois and South Dakota, and the ITER Fusion Project in France. He was inducted into the Pan-American Academy of Engineering in 2012, the National Academy of Construction in 2017, and named as a Fellow of the Design-Build Institute of America in 2019.
